

National Union of Journalists - Conspiracy to Pervert the Course of Justice

NUJ officials filed a criminal complaint against an NUJ member (28 Jun 10). The malicious allegations exposed the member to risk of arrest, imprisonment pending trial, and possible wrongful conviction and sentence.

NUJ employs a rogue lawyer, Roy Martin Mincoff as in-house solicitor. Solicitors Regulation Authority (SRA) has had Mincoff under investigation for gross professional misconduct and other alleged criminal activities for more than a year.

Prior to filing the criminal complaint, Jeremy Dear, NUJ General Secretary and Michelle Stanistreet, NUJ Deputy General Secretary coopted Barry Fitzpatrick, NUJ Head of Publishing and FoC NUJ Officials Chapel to file a false, misleading, and vexatious internal NUJ complaint (8 Apr 10) against the NUJ member. That complaint retaliated for exposing: media blackouts; harassment; denial of legal support; and abuse of an elderly NUJ member.

Fitzpatrick made a series of false, misleading, and actionable assertions not supported by facts that NUJ Glasgow accepted without question. NUJ Glasgow Branch held a hearing *in absentia* (10 Jun 10) which found “a case to answer” which amounted to nothing more than a stitch-up.

To protect himself, the NUJ member filed criminal referrals with Strathclyde and Metropolitan (Camden) police that now await a definitive response. Strathclyde Police assigned an Inspector to investigate the incident referral (15 Jun 10). Metropolitan Police (Camden) assigned a Detective Chief Inspector (DCI) to investigate the incident referral (25 Jun 10). Both referrals cite NUJ officials and staff for alleged crimes.

NUJ officials filed their false and malicious criminal allegations against the member (28 Jun 10), according to Metropolitan Police (Camden). They attempted either to preempt or to evade police investigation of the legitimate criminal referrals previously filed against NUJ officials. By that, they tried to pervert the course of justice.

The member has voluntarily withheld comment on the fraudulent NUJ police complaint (28 Jun 10), and the bizarre response to it by a Camden police constable, pending receipt of a written explanation by his superior officers. The criminal referrals made by the member effectively remain *sub judice* awaiting investigation and a definitive response by the designated Strathclyde and Metropolitan (Camden) police officers.
